I am currently an undergraduate student at the University at Albany in a degree program, and will be enrolled during the semester of my interview.

I am enrolled through general studies, taking the prerequisite science courses for my chosen health profession area of application as a post-baccalaureate student.

### I MAY PETITION FOR ELGIBILITY UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

I completed my bachelor's degree at the University at Albany within three years of the expected interview date. I understand that in order to make this request, I must petition the committee with a completed pre-health file by the first Monday in February on the spring semester in which I am requesting an interview. I understand that in addition to the normal items required for a pre-health file, I must write a letter explaining my reasons for not having participated in the committee process while I was an undergraduate. I realize that interviews are offered only every spring semester to students who have completed files by the stated deadlines, and that no interviews are offered in the summer or fall.

I request an interview with the Pre-Health Committee during the SPRING \_\_\_\_\_ semester. I understand that interviews are conducted in MARCH and APRIL and my request may be accommodated only if I submit all required materials (including receipt of the three required faculty evaluations) by the stated deadline.

I am informed that it is required that I have either completed the prerequisite science courses or that I will be completing these courses during the semester of my interview.

I am aware that the committee expects me to have gained volunteer or employment experience in the health field which I plan to enter so that I may converse realistically about the career I plan to pursue.

I know that health profession schools, in general, are seeking well-rounded individuals who are also academically capable (demonstrated by previous record) of advanced study, and that although a competitive G.P.A. is weighed heavily, it is not the only factor considered during application. If the information in my pre-health file reveals that I am not currently a competitive applicant, I realize that it is unlikely that the Pre-Health Committee will be able to offer a strong recommendation on my behalf and it is also unlikely that I will receive an acceptance to a health profession school.

I understand that the Pre-Health Committee strongly encourages students to improve their weak areas (academic or non-academic) and is willing to interview students in the following SPRING semester (provided all aforementioned conditions are met) for the NEXT application year.

I accept my responsibility to ensure that all required materials are received into my pre-health file by the stated deadline and I will contact the pre-health secretary after two weeks have passed to schedule my interview. Those with incomplete files do not receive interviews. If I do not arrive on time at the proper location for my interview, I may forfeit my chance to be interviewed. I honestly believe that I am currently a competitive applicant for a professional school and I am prepared to meet with Pre-Health Committee members.
