NOTES:

1. A grade of 'B' or better is required to waive any of the courses listed above.
2. Only those courses listed above are waivable. The maximum number of waivable credits is 10 credits.
3. As a minimum, the previous course's textbook title and author must be presented for every course a student attempts to waive. Additional information, such as course syllabus and/or catalog description will increase waivability and may be required in certain cases.
4. Calculus is no longer required but is a strongly recommended prerequisite course.
5. Waivability of coursework taken more than 3 to 4 years prior to matriculation at UAlbany will be at the discretion of the Graduate Affairs Committee.
