Course Descriptions for IIST 666:

Public Relations and Fundraising for Libraries: All libraries, regardless of focus or size, benefit from promotion strategies and development activities. This course exposes students to basic marketing, outreach, and fundraising efforts used by a variety of libraries. Assignments have been crafted to insure students understand basic concepts; identify key issues and trends; become familiar with professional and scholarly resources; and gain knowledge and understanding through reading, discussion, and group activities, as well as a variety of writing assignments.

Digital Libraries: This course will focus on methodology and techniques of creating and using digital libraries. Topics covered in the course include collection development and selection, digitization, metadata, organization, access and use of digital libraries, preservation, and project management. Students will research current issues relating to digital libraries, evaluate existing digital libraries, learn hands-on methods of developing a digital library, and work in teams to produce a small digital library. Upon completion of this course, students

will have a foundation for future research in digital libraries and should be able to participate in the planning and management of digital libraries.
