RESPONSIBILITIES: The Center for Human Services Research, University at Albany is seeking a part-time Researcher to conduct quantitative analyses of data collected for evaluations of human service programs. The primary responsibility includes manipulating a database that collects data on adolescent pregnancy prevention services. Responsibilities include computing and recoding variables to be used in statistical analyses, merging data from various sources, using statistical techniques to analyze the client and service data, write reports, prepare presentations, and prepare manuscripts for publication.

2. Substantial experience using statistical software packages such as SPSS or SAS to perform quantitative analysis and to manipulate data files
3. Experience conducting program evaluation, prevention research or social science research
