The Department of Educational Theory and Practice at the University at Albany will offer a new graduate level institute beginning in the summer of 2011.

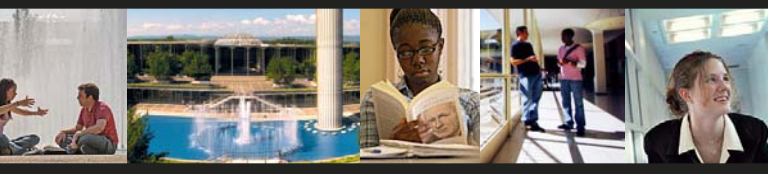

The Department of Educational Theory and Practice offers an MS degree (30 credits) in CDIT (Curriculum Development and Instructional Technology) for students who wish to extend their expertise in curriculum and instructional design and in instructional technology. It is also useful for students wishing to prepare for leadership positions in government, social service, health-related fields, corporate training, and development of educational media products.

The IOTL Institute complements our MS in CDIT degree because it caters to students whose primary goal is to understand effective *online* curricular and instructional development and design. This includes educators in a variety of settings such as public and private schools, higher education, and training sectors.
