The contract with Pike has been approved. We will be closing access through Husted at all levels on Thursday, March 22, 2007. We will install temporary detour signage on Wednesday, 3/21 and will eliminate all card access or remove the swipe card readers the morning of 3/22. Please use the second and third floor connector between Draper and Richardson to gain access from one side of the campus to the other.

The project will close off Husted completely. It is a gut rehab that will convert Husted as it exists into a 24 space classroom building with dining services located on the first floor and new entry off of the Western Ave., campus plaza. Work will be noisy at times and will affect parking in the courtyard area.
