UALBANY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT SUBMITTAL – ENERGY CODE COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

The 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State reads,

[NY] §C105.5 Written statement. When plans or specifications bear the seal and signature of a registered design professional, such registered design professional shall also include a written statement that to the best of his or her knowledge, belief and professional judgment, such plans or specifications are in compliance with the Energy Code.

and

[NY] §R105.2.2 Written statement. When plans or specifications bear the seal and signature of a registered design professional, such registered design professional shall also include a written statement that to the best of his or her knowledge, belief and professional judgment, such plans or specifications are in compliance with the Energy Code.

This written statement must be included as a part of all construction permit requests submitted to University at Albany Code Administration. This statement can be either:

- (1) a stand-alone document on business letterhead, or
- (2) contained on the Code Sheet of the submitted drawings.

The written statement may be a negative declaration that the 2020 *Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State* does not apply to any aspect of a specific construction project and its permit request application.

Wording of the written statement shall be consistent with that found in §C105.5 or §R105.2.2 of the 2020 *Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State*.
