1. Avoid Cursory Review of Concept(s)

Preferable: Discuss Fewer Points, Provide More Depth to Discussion of Particular Theory, Related Concepts, and/or Test of Theory

Recall Conceptual Thinking \Rightarrow Understanding of Subject

2. Avoid Listing Methods/Results of Journal Article(s)

More Important: Significance of Papers' Results for Theory, Ideas

3. Edit Papers

Grammar, Spelling, Proper Referencing of Sources
"Literature Cited:" Papers, Books, Internet Sources

4. First Page

Specify Topic(s), Focal Concept (s),
Outline Paper's Organization
