

The Colonial Quad Wellness Co-op: Johnson Hall A Residential Life Theme House

The Colonial Quad Wellness Co-op in Johnson Hall is a theme house focused on healthy lifestyles and programs and activities that will take place in the Colonial Quad Wellness Center. Residents of the Co-Op will serve as a manager of the Colonial Quad Wellness Center during non-traditional hours of operation. The Co-op is free of alcohol and other drugs. Although there is already a strongly enforced expectation that all residence hall rooms and public spaces comply with all federal, state, and college regulations related to the use or possession of alcohol and other drugs, the CQWC program offers an additional measure of support for those individuals who choose not to drink or use drugs.

The CQWC will live and work together, supporting each other in their pursuit of healthy living and choices. The Healthy Lifestyle living environment is defined as an area where all residents and their guests (including those of legal drinking age) agree to keep the room free at all times from substances that have the potential to damage their health or the community. These substances include, but may not be limited to, the following:

- alcohol
- tobacco products (including smokeless)
- illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- illegally obtained prescription medications

Students requesting to reside in this residence building agree to abide by the following community standards:

1. Hold one "office hour" in the Colonial Quad Wellness Center each week, advising residents about healthy choices as well as managing the fitness center.
2. Hold one wellness activity each semester with the help of your assigned suitemates, with the goal of getting all residents interested in health, nutrition, and related topics.
3. Meet regularly as a "house" to decide on important topics such as work assignments, programming themes, "house rules," and new initiatives.
4. Commit to living substance-free while enrolled in the Co-Op on Colonial Quad.
5. In addition to the use of substances (as defined above) being prohibited within Johnson Hall, problematic behaviors that result from residents being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs (i.e., drunkenness, vomiting, damages, etc.) are also prohibited. Such behaviors will be considered a violation of this agreement and can be processed judicially.

"I have read and understood, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Colonial Quad Wellness Co-Op Housing Agreement. I understand that violation of this agreement may result in administrative or judicial action which may include a reassignment to other College housing."
