

Language Living/Learning Community

Japan House

...is a living/learning community located on Dutch Quad in close proximity to the Japan Living/Learning Community. The Japan House community is designed to bring together students who wish to:

- Deepen their Japanese language skills by using the language in a residential environment;
- pursue Japanese coursework being offered by University faculty;
- combine practical language acquisition with increasing sophistication in the disciplines associated with the academic study of Japan.

Residents of this living/learning community with more than a passing interest in the Japanese language and in Japanese studies will have the opportunity to merge the courses that they are registered in with enrichment opportunities in the residence hall. Participants of the Japan House will be required to:

- Actively engage in the study of the Japanese language.
- Japanese proficiency beyond EAJ 302 OR be enrolled in one of the following:
EAJ 201, EAJ 202, EAJ 301 or EAJ 302
AND
- Be enrolled in a Japanese Studies course in both the Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters.

The success of this living/learning community is dependent upon the full participation of each of its members. Residents are expected to fulfill these requirements each semester of residency in this community. Any individual who does not fulfill these requirements may be removed from the community and placed in another residence hall.
