

Some Correlations among the Environmental Problems and Children's Illness in the Republic of Tajikistan

Republic of Tajikistan like other Central Asian NIS has many environmental problems which bring their bad impacts to the community health. In the first steps it should be mentioned access to the fresh water. In spite of Tajikistan mountains ice-houses big water sources the problem of fresh water remains actual for today especially in northern and southern regions due to great water's wasting and salting.

Within last several years flash of typhoid epidemy has been detected both in the industrial and agricultural districts. The huge number of typhoid infected victims were school children. In the Republic of Tajikistan after the USSR collapse the water supplying system is out of work and many needed reagents for proper water treatment such as coagulants are in deficit.

The Governments of European Countries and international humanitarian organizations make their contributions to the water supplying system reconstruction and some improvements in this way are visible.

In the Sogdian region due to huge salt content in drinking water local population is close to having kidney sickness. The detailed information on subject of typhoid illness, kidney sickness is shown at the presentation.

The agricultural regions have specified illness due to out of control pesticides and other chemicals used for the cotton production purpose. For example there are big percentage of illnesses among the children such as anemia, kidney sickness and weight deficit.
