

## **UA\_WPA Wireless Properties for a Third Party Vendor**

To find the software:

1. Click on the **Start Menu** and move your mouse to **All Programs**.
2. Locate the software for your card (the name will probably contains the word **wireless**) and **click** to open.
3. Your screens for configuring the properties for WPA will vary depending on the software but they all will use similar terms and field names for the settings.

### **General Settings**

Wireless Network Name (SSID): UA\_WPA

### **Security Settings**

Network Authentication: WPA (or WPA Enterprise)

Data Encryption: TKIP

Enable 802.1x: Place a checkmark (if not already there)

Authentication (EAP) type: Protected EAP (PEAP)

### **PEAP User Properties**

Authentication Method (Protocol): Secured Password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)

### **EAP-MSCHAP v2 Properties**

User credentials (possible choices):

- *Prompt each time I connect* or
- Remove the checkmark from "*Automatically use my Windows logon name and password*"

User Name: NetID

Domain: Leave Blank

Password: UNIX password

### **PEAP Server Properties**

Allow Intermediate Certificates: Place a checkmark
