It is important that they have "hands on" experience with differences and uncertainties, learn about cultural and religious diversity, and study international social and economic policies and programs that help to promote change and development. From 2000-2009, Dr. Shirley Jones, Distinguished Service Professor from the School of Social Welfare at the University at Albany took groups of students, faculty and community based practitioners in disciplines such as sociology, law, public health and social work for a two and a half week study tour to Africa. As of 2009, Dr. Jones' vision was taken up and is growing under the directionof a new Project leader, Dr. Robert Miller. Dr. Miller is an Associate Professor at the School of Social Welfare, University at Albany, and Research Director of the Center for the Elimination of Minority Health Disparities there. He was a part of the 2003 and 2004 Summer Study Tours to Africa and served as a Visiting Professor at Addis Ababa University in Ethiopia in 2006 and 2007. The group will meet with their counterparts in government and academia and deliver books and supplies to schools, orphanages and HIV/AIDS hospices. The summer study tour is part of a three and a six credit course at the University at Albany. Dr. Jones will continue to advise the Project and serve on the Fund Raising Committee.
