## ***Call for N.E.U.R.O.N. Abstracts for Publication***

The *Journal of Behavioral and Neuroscience Research (JBNR)* is an online full-text peer reviewed journal affiliated with the North East Under/graduate Research Organization for Neuroscience (*N.E.U.R.O.N.*) and published at The College of Saint Rose in Albany, NY. *JBNR* will be publishing a special issue for *N.E.U.R.O.N.* this year including poster abstracts for those presenters who wish to publish their abstracts. Only abstracts submitted to the editor-in-chief in accordance with the guidelines listed below will appear in this special issue of *JBNR*. There is no requirement, as a presenter, to submit an abstract for publication.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission – Presenters who wish to have an abstract of their poster presentation from *N.E.U.R.O.N.* published in this special issue of *JBNR* should email the abstract as an attachment (in MS-Word format) to Dr. R.W. Flint, editor-in-chief of *JBNR*, at [flintr@strose.edu](mailto:flintr@strose.edu) with the phrase “NEURON Abstract” in the subject line of the email. The document should include the title of the presentation, all authors with their corresponding affiliation(s), and an abstract (approximately 150 words). Submissions for publication should be received by Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>. Submissions received after this date may not be included in this special issue.

All presenters are also encouraged to submit a manuscript of their final project for review for publication in accordance with the instructions for authors found at the *JBNR* home page:

The general directive of *JBNR* is to publish quality research in Psychology and Neuroscience, especially studies that integrate behavioral and neuroscience techniques as commonly found in fields such as Behavioral Neuroscience, Psychoneuroimmunology, Health Psychology, Behavioral Endocrinology, Psychophysiology, Neural Imaging, Developmental Biopsychology, Comparative Psychology, Behavioral Genetics, Psychopharmacology, and Neuropsychology. *JBNR* provides an outlet for research at all levels, and by incorporating a *Brief Reports* section, the journal makes a specific effort to promote behavioral and neuroscience research at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
