**Robert D. McEvoy ICMA-CM**  
**Public Service Professor**  
**Nelson A. Rockefeller College of Public Affairs and Policy**

Professor McEvoy has instructed, advised, and helped place Rockefeller College students in local government career positions, since 1980. He has also taught at the Babes-Bolyai University in Cluj, Romania where he is a distinguished professor. He began his professional education in public administration at New York University where he received the MPA degree in 1973 and was admitted to the doctoral program. He was completing his course requirements and assembling his committee when he was recruited to become the county manager of Schenectady County in upstate New York where he served for 22 years.

Professor McEvoy's teaching and research focus on local government and intergovernmental structures, systems and services throughout the world including professional management and performance measurement/management. He has been a member of the National Civic League's Model City and County Charter Committees and the Government Accounting Standards Board Advisory Council. He has consulted with and addressed governments from Europe, Asia, Africa, and South America; most recently members of the Parliament of Kenya. He is currently assisting with restructuring questions, management personnel, or performance measurement/management in five New York State communities. He is a member of the GASB SEA (performance reporting) Task Force.

Professor McEvoy is a credentialed manager and the executive director of the New York State City/County Management Association. He was also a city and village manager and a vice president of the International City/County Management Association where he was awarded ICMA's Distinguished Service Award on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2004. He currently serves on the ICMA Government Affairs and Policy Committee which formulates and prepares national positions for the National Association of Counties, National League of Cities and similar organizations. He is also a member of the ICMA Credentialing Advisory Board which reviews applications and continuing education plans for professional credentialing.

Professor McEvoy is the managing editor and editorial page author of the Journal of County Administration, a national publication, and the New York State Local Government Administration Review. He is a member of the International advisory Board of the Transylvanian Review of Administrative Sciences.

He has been the president of the Empire State Capitol Area Chapter of the American Society for Public Administration where he received the Frank C. Moore Award “for distinguished contributions to local government service.” He also is a past president of the New York state City/County Management Association and the Municipal Administrators Association. He is a fellow of the State Academy of Public Administration.
