Note: These data are from the National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services (N-SSATS), which is conducted by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. The survey includes both public and private treatment facilities in the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and U.S. territories and protectorates. The reference date for the 1998 and 2000 N-SSATS was October 1; for the 2002 N-SSATS it was March 29; for the 2003 through 2006 N-SSATS it was March 31; and for 2007 it was March 30. A total of 15,188 facilities were eligible for the 2007 survey; data were received for 14,359 facilities for a response rate of 94.5%. After exclusion of responding facilities deemed out of the scope of the survey focus, there were 13,648 eligible respondents for the 2007 N-SSATS. "Clients in treatment" include hospital inpatient and non-hospital residential clients receiving substance abuse services at the facility on the reference dates, and outpatient clients who were seen at the facility for a substance abuse treatment or detoxification service at least once during the month prior to the survey and who were still enrolled in treatment on the reference date.

<sup>a</sup>Data for facilities operated by Federal agencies are included in the States in which the facilities are located.

<sup>b</sup>Excludes clients in facilities that did not provide data for clients under 18 years of age: in 2003, 4,493 total clients reported by 51 facilities; in 2004, 2,482 total clients reported by 58 facilities; in 2005, 9,324 total clients reported by 81 facilities; in 2006, 3,471 total clients reported by 156 facilities; and in 2007, 550 total clients reported by 34 facilities.
