Note: These data are from the National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services (N-SSATS), which is conducted by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. The survey includes both public and private treatment facilities in the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and U.S. territories and protectorates. The reference date for the 1998 and 2000 N-SSATS was October 1; for the 2002 N-SSATS it was March 29; for the 2003 through 2006 N-SSATS it was March 31; and for 2007 it was March 30. A total of 15,188 facilities were eligible for the 2007 survey; data were received for 14,359 facilities for a response rate of 94.5%. After exclusion of responding facilities deemed out of the scope of the survey focus, there were 13,648 eligible respondents for the 2007 N-SSATS.

^aData for facilities operated by Federal agencies are included in the States in which the facilities are located.
