

Registration Process

To register, please go to:

If you have already joined the NYSDOH's Learning Management System, simply log in. If not, click on "Click Here" on the left upper hand side. (below **Login**)



You will be asked to create a profile. Please complete all required fields and include your agency name in the first line of your work address, in addition to the Agency drop down menu.

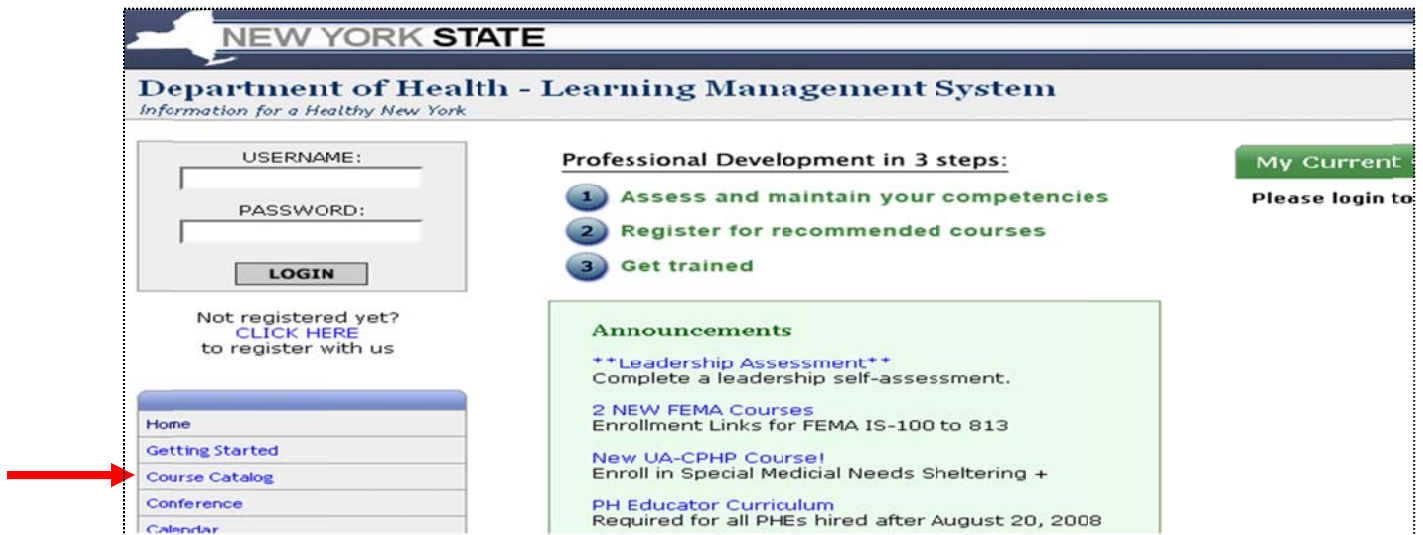
Once you have completed your profile, please click on "Submit your Registration".

Field Epi 201: Practical Skills in Outbreak Investigation
Expanding upon skills gained in the *Field Epi 101: Outbreak Investigation* course, this is a five-week, on-line course for staff in local health departments, including public health nurses and sanitarians. Experienced field epidemiologist, Stan Kondracki, will mentor the on-line course. Utilizing Moodle, the course will consist of on-line webinars (live and recorded), discussion forums, and online activities. Students will be expected and encouraged to dialogue with fellow classmates through online discussion boards and webinars. The course will be based on Tier 1 competencies for epidemiology as established by the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists.
