Frequently Asked Questions

Are Contact Hours/ Credits available?

The University at Albany School of Public Health is an Approved Provider of continuing nurse education by the Northeast Multi-State Division, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation. This offering is approved for 3.5 nursing contact hours. Provider #NY04. This offering is approved for 3.5 nursing contact hours.

We additionally offer Social Work credits. The University at Albany, School of Social Welfare is recognized by the New York State Education Department's State Board for Social Work as an approved provider of continuing education for licensed social workers. Provider #0011. This offering is approved for 1.75 contact hours.

To request credits, you must:

1. View all three Screen modules in their entirety
2. Complete the online evaluation
3. Achieve a minimum score of 80% on the post-test
4. Complete the Individual Application for Continuing Education Credits

How long will the post-test take?

Unlike the modules, the post-test is NOT SELF-PACED. The system will sign you off if you are not active. Depending on the participant it can take anywhere from 20 to 60 minutes to complete the 20 question post-test.

It is **highly recommended** participants print out all handouts and use these resources while taking the post-test.

How do I find out my post test results?

A passing score is 80%. If you do not achieve a passing score on the post-test, you will be notified via email within 10 business days and given instructions for retaking the post test.

If you pass the post test, you will receive a certificate and Screener ID via email within 4 weeks from the date in which you passed the post test.

If I failed, can I retake the post-test? Will I have to pay additional fees to retake the exam?

You may retake the post-test up to two times without paying additional fees. We strongly encourage you to review the online modules prior to retaking the post test.

When will I receive my New York State Screener Identification Number and Certificate of Completion?

You will receive a certificate and a Screener ID via email within 4 weeks of **passing** the post-test. It is vital you provide a valid email that you frequently check.

Will the Screen Training and Certification modules run on my Mac laptop?

Screen Training and Certification modules can be run on both PC and Mac but we recommend you have the most recent Adobe Flash update.
