Registration for Summer and Fall 2009 Doctoral Students in Social Welfare

Time to think about registration for Summer and Fall 2009! Registration begins at 6:00 a.m., on Tuesday, April 1st. If you plan to take academic courses (including the doctoral proseminars), you should register as early as possible to ensure a seat in the class. If you plan to take MSW courses, registration is first-come, first-served, so register early!

To help you register for Summer and Fall 2009, this packet contains:

1. Academic Calendars for Summer and Fall 2009
2. Social Welfare Course Schedules for Summer and Fall 2009
3. Call Numbers for Dissertation Credits, Independent Studies, Independent Research, General Readings, and Doctoral Internship

SUMMARY OF STEPS FOR REGISTRATION:

1. Consult with your advisor to plan your coursework and to get an Advisement Verification Number (AVN) for the next semester.
2. Beginning at 6:00 a.m. March 31, 2009, register for all your courses via the MyUAlbany student registration system at www.albany.edu/myualbany. An online tutorial of registering using MyUAlbany is also available at this website.
3. Arrange payment for your courses by the **first day of the semester**.

Details of How to Register:

Step 1: As always, **you must consult with your advisor**. Many advisors will do this by telephone, especially if you are registering only for dissertation credits. Your advisor will give you a new AVN.

Several sources are available to help you select courses. The course schedule for the School of Social Welfare is included in this packet. If you wish to take MSW-level courses, you may get a description of advanced and elective courses from the School of Social Welfare HelpDesk in RI-117 or contact them at ((518) 442-5322 or sswhelp@albany.edu). If you wish to take courses elsewhere in the University, the University's Summer and Fall Course Schedules will be available online at http://www.albany.edu/schedule_of_classes/. Most courses require only a class number to register.

If you are taking dissertation credits (SSW 899), register using the class number for your committee chair. The class numbers are on the list in this packet. You will need a permission number (formerly referred to as a section key number or SKN) for dissertation credits.

Courses that require independent work also require permission from the instructor via a permission number. You must get registration material from the faculty member involved. Such independent work includes Independent Study (SSW 690), Independent Research (SSW 760), Doctoral Internship (SSW 854), and General Readings in Social Welfare and Social Work (SSW 888), and Dissertation Credits (SSW 899). You, the faculty member, and your advisor must sign an Independent Study form (on the forms rack outside RI-117) and turn the form in to the Associate Dean's Office (RI-118). The faculty member will give you **the class number and permission number** needed to register for these credits.

Step 2: Register for all of your courses, whether master's or doctoral, whether in social welfare or elsewhere in the University, beginning at 6:00 a.m., Tuesday, March 31, 2009. The sooner you register, the more likely you are to get your first choice of courses.

To register, log onto MyUAlbany at www.albany.edu/myualbany. When you register, you will need the following information:

Your NET ID
Your PIN number
Your (new) AVN for Summer or Fall 2009 semester (from your advisor)
The four-digit class numbers for each course

If you have a question or *problem with the registration system*, call the ITS Help Desk at (518) 442-3700 for assistance.

If you have a *problem registering for a social work course*, call the School of Social Welfare Help Desk at (518) 442-5320.

You do not need permission numbers unless the course is independent work or the course is closed. The course instructors will have the permission numbers.

The University's MyUAlbany registration system is generally available from 6:00am to 2:30am.

1. Step 3: Arrange payment for your courses. Bills for Summer Session will be available at the end of May and will be due either June 15 or July 15. Bills for the Fall semester will be available in July and will be due August 15. For further information please contact Student Accounts at 518-442-3202.

Participation does not require extensive computer skills, although it helps to have some comfort with the web and email.
