The safety of our students is the University's highest priority - both on and off campus. There are many steps we can and do take to improve our safety as individuals, as a University community and as a part of the greater Capital District community.

In order to continue to address safety concerns by students, faculty and staff, a series of "Safety Forums" will be held on the following dates and times:

- * Monday, October 27 at 7pm on Alumni Quad Movie Room (Alden Hall)
- * Tuesday, October 28 at 8pm in the Campus Center Assembly Hall (2nd Floor)
- * Thursday, November 6 at 4:00pm at the Downtown Campus Arthur Levitt Room (between Milne and Page Halls)

The first of these forums was held the day following Richard Bailey's tragic death and members of the UAlbany community in attendance were able to raise questions and concerns with University Police, the University's Office of Personal Safety and Off-Campus Affairs, and the Albany City Police Department.

Additionally, a "frequently asked questions" site has been set up to inform the campus community about matters surrounding the death of UAlbany senior Richard Bailey, efforts to support our students through this difficult time, as well as to share information on safety-related issues. An ongoing dialogue surrounding issues of safety is critical to the welfare of our community, and I hope you will consider joining us at one of the forums.
