Student Legal Services of the Student Association (SLS) is a legal service funded by the undergraduate Activity Fee providing legal assistance to eligible University at Albany undergraduates.

Litigation (“in court”) Representation

Fall and Spring semesters, trial representation for eligible students charged with Misdemeanors, Violations and selected City Ordinances, in most local courts of Albany County; and Summary Proceeding representation for eligible students threatened with Eviction. SLS does not provide any other litigation representation.

Consultations:

Off-campus housing issues, small claims, traffic violations, personal injury claims, consumer problems, University disciplinary and academic issues, etc. SLS does not provide litigation representation for those problems or claims against the University at Albany, or the State of New York. SLS does not draft or file Notices of Claim or advise organizations other than student groups.

Where SLS provides a consultation only, SLS seeks to enable the student to handle his or her legal issues without a lawyer. Otherwise, SLS may provide a referral.

SLS does not provide any assistance to students whose legal interests conflict with those of another eligible student.

Academic Internship - Community Legal Education:

SLS offers an internship for academic credit with the School of Criminal Justice (RCRJ 423) and may be available for community legal education activities.

SLS is located in Campus Center 116. Services provided according to the Code of Professional Responsibility and SLS' Eligibility Policy. Proof of eligible student status is required. SLS reserves the right to refuse assisting anyone and to alter its services without notice.
