Students are required to have a valid UAlbany identification card known as a SUNYCard.

A SUNYCard provides access to:

- Your residence hall, library services, and UAlbany busing
- Meal Plans and Munch Money in vending and at food venues
- Podium account usage at various locations

If you lose your SUNYCard, immediately deactivate it at :

- The University Police Department, located near Indian Quad (Monday through Friday after 5:00 PM and Saturdays and Sundays)

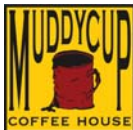
Students who are waiting for funds to become available through Financial Aid may have funds advanced to their SUNYCard Podium account in order to make purchases of items such as books and supplies.

UAS will advance up to \$650 on your Podium account each semester, with the \$650 billed to your tuition account. The Podium Advance program is available through the first two weeks of each semester.

DINING

UAS is continually working to improve the dining experience for University at Albany students. Within the past three years, Dutch and Colonial Quad Dining Rooms have been renovated, and the completely new Indian Quad Dining Room reopens for fall 2009 featuring cooked-to-order dining.

The State Quad Dining Room will be closed for renovation during the 2009-2010 school year (see architect's renderings above). In preparation for this, a new take-out dining facility has been constructed on State Quad, and State Quad residents will have five all-you-care-to-eat dining facilities along with the Campus Center food court venues available to them.

Meal Plans are accessed with your SUNYCard and have three components:

Meals, which can be used by you in any of the all-you-care-to-eat dining rooms, and to treat a friend to dine with you. Regular dining room hours are 7:30 AM to 8:00 PM. Dining Rooms are located in the University residential quads.

Meal Trades, which are meal combinations available at Campus Center food locations and in late-night venues located in residential dining rooms. When you swipe your card for a meal trade, a meal is deducted from your meal plan balance. For specific meal trade options, times and locations, visit albany.edu/uas.

Munch Money, a declining balance account used to purchase tax free snacks, beverages, and additional meals at UAlbany food venues or in vending machines from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Munch Money carries over from semester to semester as long as you purchase a meal plan for each semester.

Choosing a Meal Plan

- Incoming students residing in traditional campus housing are automatically assigned to Plan 2, which includes 15 meals each week and \$200 Munch Money per semester.
- Returning students residing in traditional campus housing are automatically assigned the same meal plan they had the previous semester.

Changing a Meal Plan

You may change your Meal Plan through the 10th business day after the start of Meal Plans for the semester at:

VENDING



A full range of beverages, snacks, and food items are available 24/7 in UAlbany vending machines.

If you make your purchases with your SUNYCard, the cost will be subtracted from your Podium account. Podium is accepted 24/7. If you make your purchases with your SUNYCard and have a meal plan, the cost will be deducted from your Munch Money between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM. If you do not have Munch Money remaining, the cost will be deducted from your Podium account.

Convenient storage during the summer

- Alternative Storage delivers storage containers to campus

- Alternative Storage picks up and stores the containers
- Alternative Storage returns the containers to campus when you are ready for your items
