NEW Leadership™ New York (NLNY) is an undergraduate leadership development program for women that instills the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for effective political engagement and community organizing. NEW Leadership™ New York is the first and only program of its kind in New York State, and is part of The National Education for Women's (NEW) Leadership Network.

NLNY participants will be engaged in leadership self-development activities, trained to promote the principles of leadership through action and will conduct a community service project.

NLNY is supported by foundations, corporations and individual donors. To ensure that this unique learning opportunity is available to all eligible students regardless of their personal financial situations, participating schools are asked to pay a \$250 per student fee to help defray costs.
