

TEAM PROJECTS (25 points)

Team presentations (10 Points)

Each team will make a presentation on a topic assigned by the instructor. You should spend about 30 minutes on the presentation demonstrating a certain skill with the appropriate application. You should hand out instruction sheets and make these instructions available online. After the presentation the class will perform 2-3 mini projects/exercises designed by your team aimed at teaching a skill that the class can incorporate into their homepage. These exercises should be designed to take 30 minutes of class time bringing the total length of the team project to approximately one hour. During the exercises you will assist the instructor in guiding the class that day as we all work on that skill.

Web Team Software Demo, Landing Page, and Tutorial (15 Points)

Students will take the lead in teaching the class how to use one special feature of a specific program:

1. Work as a group to learn the program in advance of class
2. Teach the class how to develop a web page based on step-by-step procedures.
3. Every student presents "how-to" instructions from the podium for part of the demonstration and then assists in troubleshooting student questions with other members of the web team.
4. **Meet with me as a team in advance of your software demo to discuss your plans**
5. Write a quick reference step-by-step tutorial for the demo and post this document in advance of the lab on the web.
6. Create a web team example page (based on the technique your team is demonstrating).
7. Develop a **Web Team Landing Page** that links to your tutorial and the home pages of everyone on your team.

Points will be assigned to each group participant based on the effectiveness of the presentation, the ability of each group member to work together and to assist the class, and the relevance of the software or coding demonstration in relation to the overall course. Students who are absent on the required group presentation date (or who do not work with their group) will not receive points for this assignment. This assignment cannot be rescheduled. Feedback from students on the team indicating that someone is not doing their part will result in a reduced grade for the student who does not complete the required work (or does not cooperate with the team).
