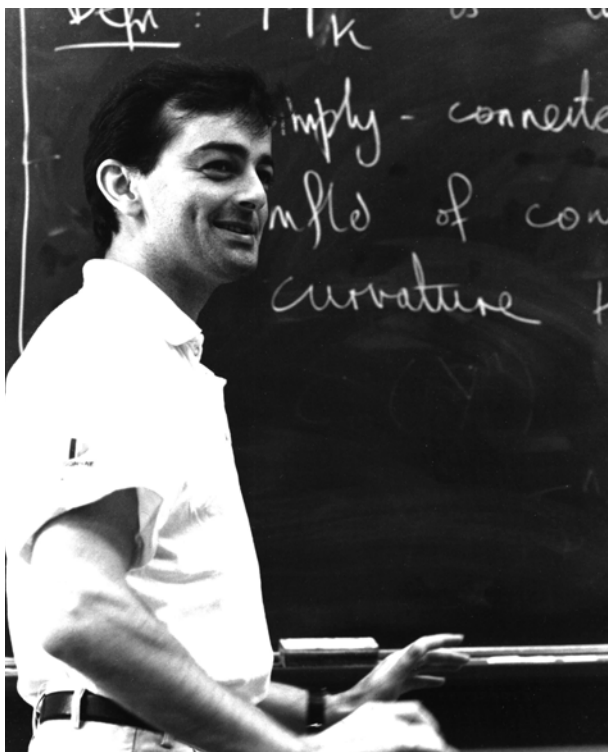
REGIONAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE IN THE MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES
