Spisak, a graduate student in Prof. Petrukhina's group, has been selected as a recipient for a 2012 Ludo Frevel Crystallography Scholarship Award by The International Centre for Diffraction Data (ICDD). As a non-profit, scientific organization, the ICDD serves as the world center for quality diffraction data through worldwide scientific contributions from academe, government, and industry. The Ludo Frevel Crystallography Scholarship Fund was established to encourage promising graduate students to pursue crystallography-oriented research. Its name was adopted to honor a pioneer in the science of X-ray diffraction and the founder of the fund, Dr. Ludo Frevel.
