Undergraduate students can receive up to \$17,500 per year in scholarships for all 4 years of study

University at Albany- Zimbabwe Alliance

- Zimbabwean students have the option to study in both undergraduate and graduate programs
- University at Albany commits specific scholarships to aid Zimbabwean students in order to make studying at the university affordable
- Zimbabwean students who have completed three A-level exams with a grade of C or better will receive advanced standing and be eligible to complete their degree at University at Albany in three years, lessening the cost of a degree by 25%
- Each year, we enroll students from at least 13 countries in Sub-Saharan Africa
- University at Albany is located in the vibrant capital of New York State, allowing our students the opportunity to explore tremendous cultural and recreational experiences both on and off campus
- International alumni from the university have gone on to work for the United Nations, World Bank and leading multinational corporations including Goldman Sachs, General Electric, Ernst & Young and Deloitte
