Q: How do I register for online, self-paced MDS 3.0 training?

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Course Navigation and Technical Issues

Q: What computer/IT requirements are necessary to take the course online?

A: The computer you intend to use for this online training will need to have a Recent Web Browser (Internet Explorer 10+, Firefox, Chrome or Edge).

You will need computer speakers or headphones to listen to the audio in the modules.

Q: How long will it take me to complete the online MDS modules?

A: Except for the first module (1hr) each MDS module is approximately 2 hours long.

Q: Do you need to complete each module in one sitting?

A: No, you do not have to complete the module all in one sitting. You can start and stop the modules at your convenience. When you return the module will resume where you left off.

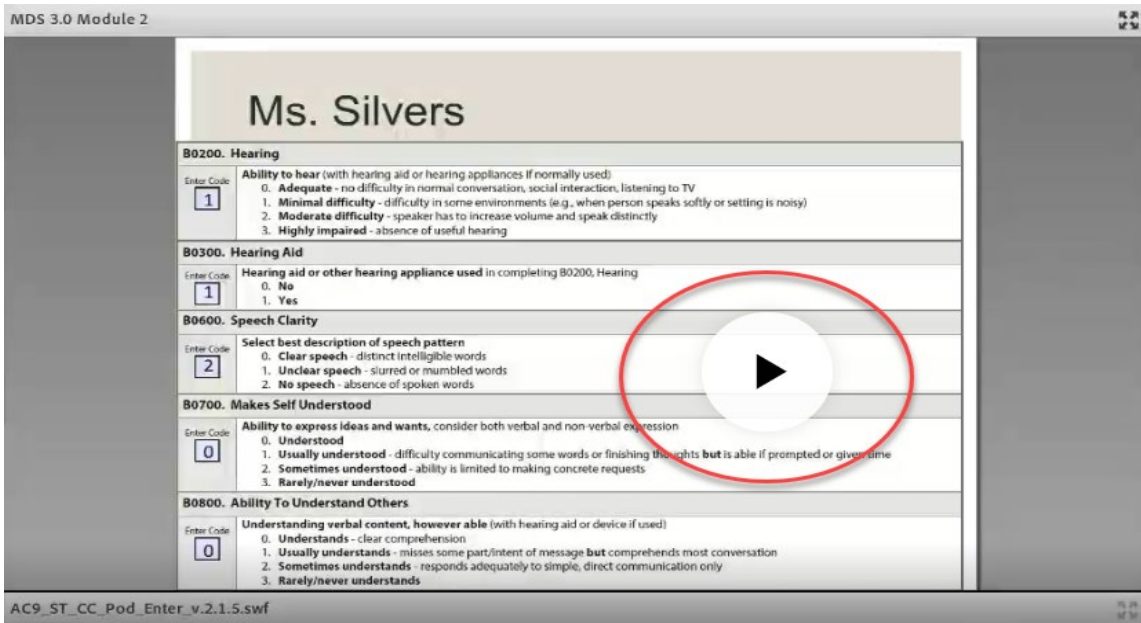


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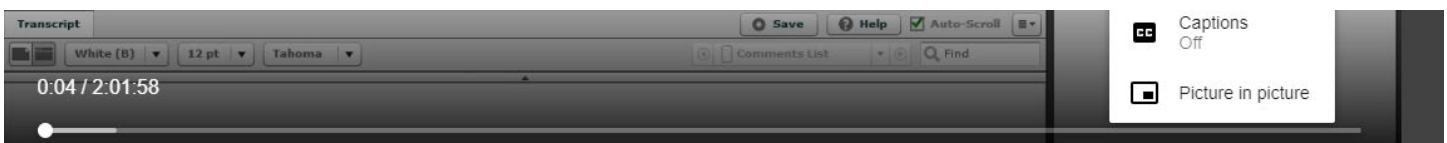
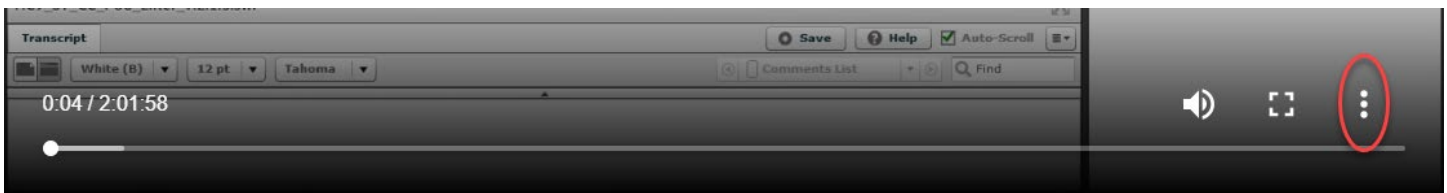
Q: How do I play/pause the video?

A: Press the triangle in the middle of the video screen.



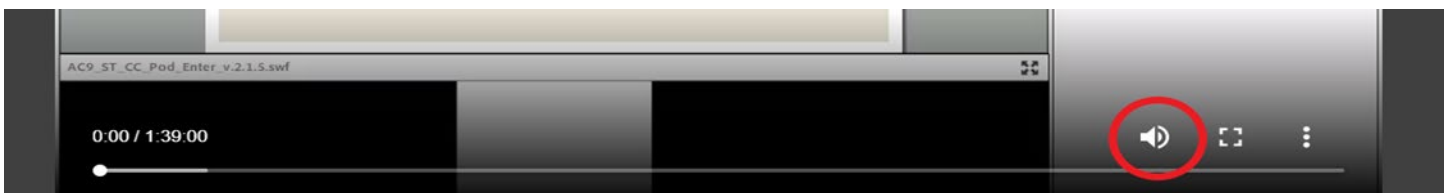
Q: How do I turn on/off Closed Captioning?

A. Click on the three dots on the right hand side of the play bar. This will give you the option to turn on or turn off the closed captioning.



Q: How do I adjust the volume?

Click on the speaker symbol in the video to mute the recording. Use your computer features to adjust the volume.





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Q: How long will I be able to access the trainings and my completion certificates?

Q: Are continuing education credits available for these modules?

A: Yes, contact hours in nursing continuing education are available. An evaluation and post-test (with a passing score of 80%) are required to receive continuing education credits. A: There are 5 post-test questions after each module.

Q: After taking this training, will I be certified in MDS?

A: New York State does not require a certification in MDS. However, University at Albany, School of Public Health is the only MDS training approved by the New York State Department of Health.

Participants will receive a certificate of completion when they finish the evaluation and post-test after each module.

Q: What is the difference between these self-paced modules and the live webinars you offer?

A: These modules are the recordings of the live webinars we offer. It is the same training offered with the convenience of learning on your own schedule with access available for one whole year from the date of purchase.



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Q: How do I access the evaluation and posttest?

A: After you have completed the video, a “Course Evaluation” button will appear under “Next Step”. Click the button to access both the evaluation and the posttest.
