INFLUENZA RELATED ACRONYMS

- ILI: influenza like illness
- IIV: inactivated influenza vaccine
 - IIV3: trivalent IIV
 - IIV4: quadrivalent IIV
 - SD-IIV: standard-dose IIV
 - HD-IIV: high-dose IIV
 - ccIIV: cell culture-based IIV
 - aIIV: adjuvanted IIV
- RIV: recombinant influenza vaccine
- LAIV: live attenuated influenza vaccine (nasal spray)
 - LAIV4: quadrivalent LAIV
