Part 3 – Execution

- System configuration to be determined by Architect and University representative based on space requirements and client needs.
- Assembly to follow manufacturers guidelines
- Must meet California Standard 117 (General Application)
- Must meet California Standard 133 (Overnight Application)
- Cabinets to be constructed from metal
- Work surface to be constructed of wood core with decorative laminate finish
- Surface to contain either Grommet or Scallop openings for cable organization
- Circuitry to correspond with Electrical Drawings with respect to circuits / neutral wiring.
- Electrical components to be mechanically grounded per Manufacturer and Electrical Drawings
- Components must meet no less than Level 2 Certification to the BIFMAe3 Sustainability Standard
