

Office of Sustainability Garden and Compost Summer Internship

Internship Description:

The Office of Sustainability is seeking one motivated and energetic intern to assist with caring for the UAlbany Heritage Garden, managing the Office Composting Program, and assist with planning for the fall semester. The intern is expected to complete 60-100 hours over the summer. Internship is unpaid, though students may obtain 2-3 academic credit through the Community and Public Service Program.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- UAlbany Heritage Garden- Assist with planning layout and timing for plantings with assistance of Heritage Garden Committee members. Maintain watering schedule. Perform weeding when needed. Take pictures and document changes in garden.
- Office Composting Program- Collect compost weekly and communicate effectively with participating offices.

2. Project-oriented with strong self-initiative
3. Adaptable to organizational changes and new projects
4. Positive attitude, commitment and follow-through
