### **SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR COMMUTER STUDENTS**

- Locate quiet study areas - on and off campus
- Bus schedules: CDTA and the UAlbany bus (go to [www.albany.edu](http://www.albany.edu) and click on site index, then bus schedules)
- Backpack/ Book bag
- Lock for athletic lockers
- You must purchase parking permit for your vehicle at the Office of Parking and Mass Transit Services – only those living in parents' home within 50 miles
- If commuting by car – emergency road coverage, jumper cables, shovel, sand, extra clothes and a blanket in winter months
