- 8. What is the difference between social and cultural organizations?

- 10. Do you believe this is going to be a valuable experience to yourself and to the community?

## **10 Things to Consider When Joining a Fraternal Organization:** 5.

- 1. Choose an organization (social or cultural).
- 2. Go to all on-campus recruitment events before you make your decision.
- Have a meeting with fraternity and sorority life Advisor (Arleny Alvarez-Peña) and/or the All Greek Council Directors before you make your decision.
- 4. Get to know other students who want to join fraternity and sorority Life

- 5. Do not join if you are taking a lot of courses, or especially challenging courses.
- 6. Have a 2.65 or better cumulative GPA.
- 7. Make a pros and cons list.
- 8. Talk to some of the brothers/sisters about how they feel about fraternity and sorority life.
- 9. Think carefully about the value of fraternity and sorority life.
- 10. Do it for yourself, not because anyone is telling you to do it.
