


Accessing ISSS's Pre-Orientation on Blackboard


1.) Log in to Blackboard with your NETID and Password: <https://blackboard.albany.edu>

2.) Click on the "Community" Tab in the Upper Right



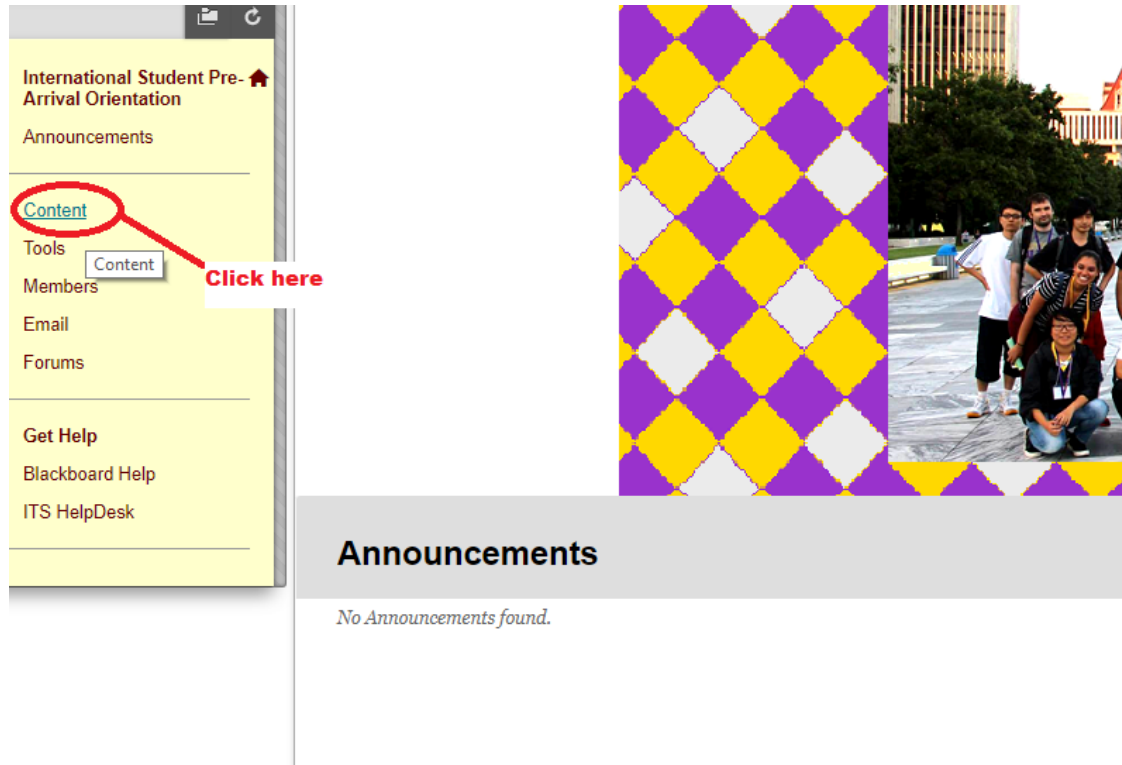

4.) From within the page, click on “Content” to access the required materials and quiz. Each module under the “Content” page is accessed by clicking on the title, which is an active link. Click on “Forums” to chat with other students and ISSS staff in the topic specific message boards.



5.) Once you have reviewed all of the required materials in the Content folders, you may complete the required pre-Orientation quiz. All new students must take and pass this pre-Orientation quiz prior to arrival to the U.S.. This quiz consists of a compilation of the information you learned from all of the modules. **A passing score is 85% (30/35).** Students may retake the quiz as many times as needed in order to pass.
