**Actor, Co-Founder, Black Door Theatre Company**

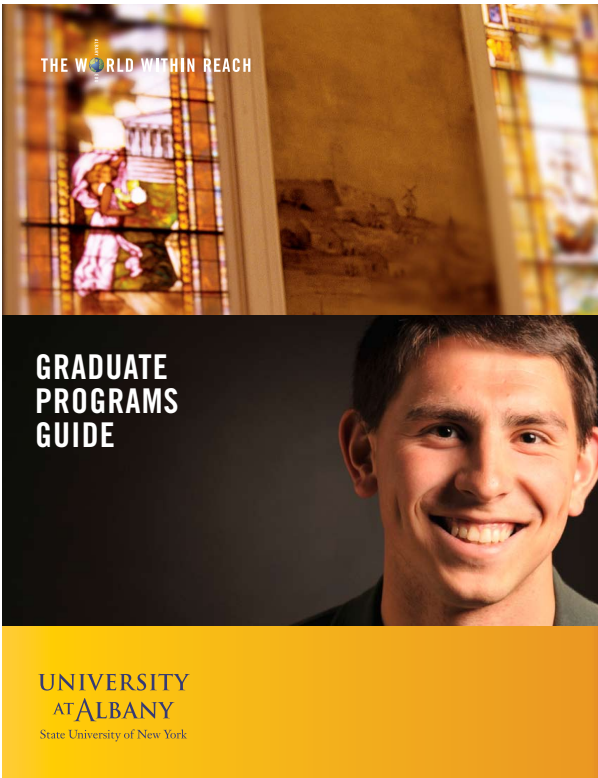
