Yo Jackson is a board-certified clinical child psychologist and a professor in the Clinical Child Psychology Program in the Psychology department at Penn State University. She is also the Associate Director of the Child Maltreatment Solutions Network.

Her research focuses on the mechanisms of resilience for youth exposed to trauma and developing models of the process from exposure to outcome for youth and families.

Dr. Jackson also studies intergenerational transmission of trauma and methods and measurement in child maltreatment research.
